PROGRAM FOR TENTS OF ENCOUNTER

INTENTION:

- To create a space where members can connect across the Society.
- To encourage an inclusive spirit towards the General Chapter.
- Sisters get to know about new things happening in new provinces across the society.
- To reflect the synodal dynamics of the Church that are taking place around the world.

PROCESS:

Instructions: (5 minutes)

Opening: prayer (5 minutes)

Main Dialogue : presentations, plenary, concluding remarks (70 minutes)

Each conversation will be in two parts.

First, 2-3 new provinces will share (7 minutes each) about what new things they have been doing to build relationships and/or create the new province. There will be time for people to add information about what is happening in their new provinces, make comments or ask questions.

In the second part, an a specialist will share about the specific topic for 7 to 8 minutes, and then people who want to say something are free to share.

Anjet van Linge will conclude the meeting with her closing remarks. (7 minutes)

These encounters are primarily about listening and sharing, so your questions will be heard but not necessarily answered.

Collecting the fruit of our conversation : (15 minutes)

At the end of the meeting 3- minute silence.

Invitation to write in the chat what you heard .

2-minute silence

Invitation to write in the chat what remains with you.

Conclusion – Chapter prayer.
